Now lastly, while the brooch and its ancient palindrome tickles our romantic fancy, there is a small hassle in actually procuring the artifact for public display in a museum. That is because the ancient object was originally discovered by an amateur with a metal detector in 2015 (like in the case of the Roman Cupid Ring , also found last year).
